Saratoga Hospital Backstretch Clinic

The Backstretch Clinic, opened in 2009, provides comprehensive healthcare services to backstretch workers each year during the Saratoga meet. These physicians serve as primary care providers for these patients who do not always have access to doctors, despite the fact that at least half suffer from preexisting conditions like diabetes and hypertension. The team at the Backstretch Clinic sees approximately 800 patients each season.

Saratoga Hospital, with financial support from John Hendrickson and in partnership with the New York Racing Association and BEST (Backstretch Employee Service Team of NY), will break ground on a new clinic space this July.
